Conference Cause

Reflecting the generosity of the professional liability industry each year at the PLUS Conference.

Since 2004:

- \$426,000 in grants to 11 different charities
- 11 volunteer events, engaging 625 volunteers
- 1,965 hours of volunteer service contributed



- 2014 Sunrise Children's Foundation, Las Vegas: 38 PLUS members volunteered at the Sunrise Children's Foundation, assembling 250 Thanksgiving meal baskets for families that participate in the organization's programs. \$43,475 in support was donated to this great organization.

Chapter Charity Grants

Enabling members to connect with each other and make a difference in their communities by supporting charities that they choose.

Since 2004:

- \$526,500 in grants to 165 different charities
- 89 volunteer events across the U.S. & Canada
- 1,080 PLUS member volunteers engaged in service

- 2014: \$73,000 in grants to 37 charities. Thanks to the time and talent of our members, 13 volunteer events facilitated the giving of over 120 hours of service.
